## Enrolment Information for Parents Seeking Enrolment at St Therese School Under the Education & Training Act (2020)

St Therese School has a maximum roll of 165 pupils at primary level, from New Entrants to Year 8. The school can accept up to a maximum of 5% (9) non-preference children if places are available after all preference children are accepted.

- 1. State integrated school select preference students on the following grounds:
  - A. The agent for determining preference are the listed Agents of the Bishop, who may sign the Certificate on his Behalf:
    - a) Parish Priest of their Parish of Residence
    - b) Assistant Priest of their Parish of Residence
    - c) Priests appointed under c.517/1
    - d) Deacons and lay persons appointed to pastoral care under c.517/2
    - e) Ethnic chaplains who liaise with Parish Priests or their delegate
    - f) Local committees appointed by the Bishop by any of the above agents of the Bishop
  - B. Criteria for Preference of Enrolment in Integrated Catholic Schools
    - 5.1 The child has been baptized or is being prepared for baptism in the Catholic Church.
    - 5.2 The child's parents/guardians have already allowed one or more of the siblings to be baptized in the Catholic faith.
    - 5.3 At least one parent/guardian is a Catholic, and although their child has not yet been baptized, the child's participation in the life of the school could lead to the parents having the child baptized.
    - 5.4 With the agreement of the child's parent/guardian, a significant familial adult such as a grandparent, aunt or uncle who is actively involved in the child's upbringing undertakes to support the child's formation in the faith and practices of the Catholic Church.
    - 5.5. One or both of the child's non-Catholic parents/quardians is preparing to become Catholic.
- 2. State integrated school shave places for non-preference students.
  - a) This school have a maximum of 9 places.
  - b) Therese are currently 4 places available in 2021.
  - c) The school roll is now at 47% of its maximum.
  - d) Non-Preferences places criteria:
    - 1. The application accept that they will be attending a school of special character and that their place in the school is conditional on their participating in the programme.



- 2. The application accept that they will be required to pay attendance dues as set by the proprietor and these are not voluntary.
- e) Non-Preference criteria that apply to this school.
  - 1. The siblings of non-preference students already in the school.
  - 2. The children of staff or Board members who seek to enrol their children.
  - 3. Siblings of former non-preference students.
  - 4. Non-preference students coming from another integrated school with the same special character.
  - 5. Other children if a vacancy exists after all non-preference children have been accepted and there are no children on the Preference Waiting List.
  - 6. Non-Preference students who cannot enrol immediately may choose to be placed on a Waiting List. Students on this list are wait listed in date and will be contacted in places become available. Acceptance is at the discretion of the Principal.
