MID-YEAR REPORTS



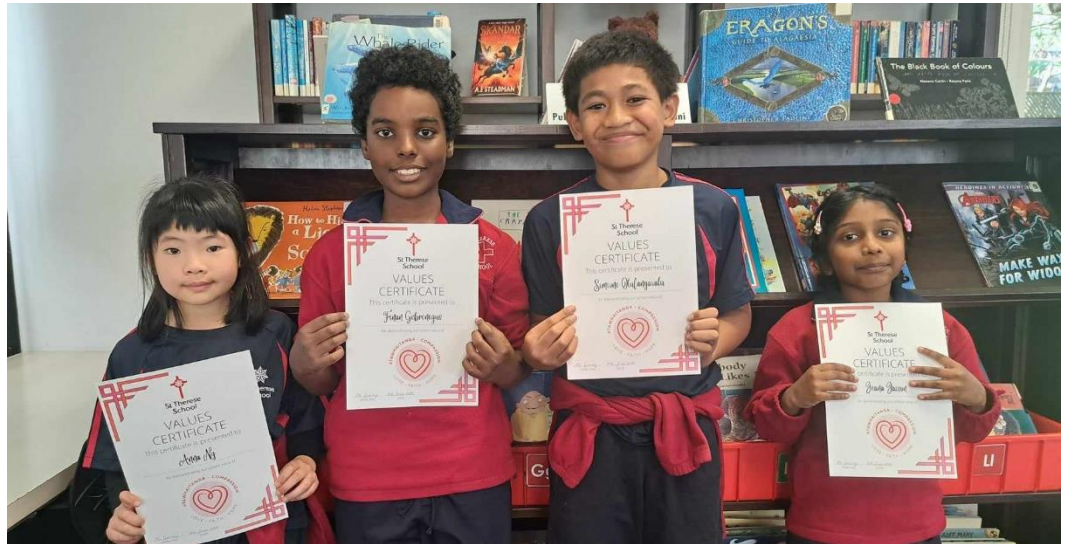
